The site wardens 'Bramble and Milo' have managed the heat very well with emergency ice creams from our park shop and finding shade out of the sun.

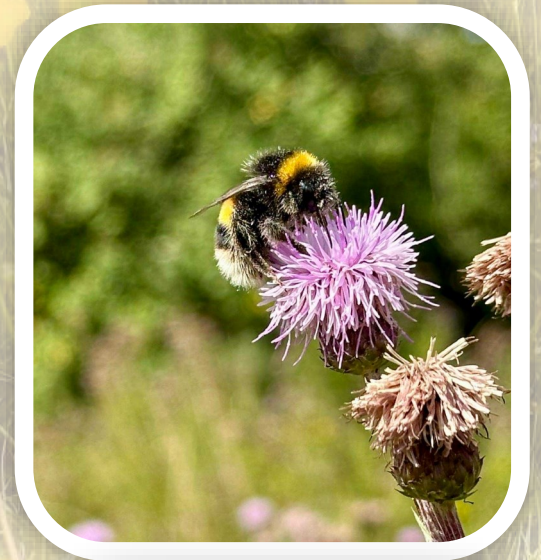


Our Very own Grange Honey

Tim the Senior Species and Recording Officer at the Leicestershire & Rutland Wildlife Trust will be visiting The Grange Caravan Park on the weekend of Friday 31st July to Saturday 1st August to record findings of insects and wildlife that live alongside us on our park. Since developing the park three years ago much of the planting that we have done and continue to do has established and broadened the species which inhabits our site. Our pond life has also added

to these visitors. With the expert help of Tim we will be able to record these findings Tim will be placing a moth trap out for the Friday evening as well as using bat Detectors to help collate the data, along with other finds, on the Saturday afternoon.

This will be an exciting opportunity to come along and take part in our data collection, so please do feel free to join us throughout the free event.

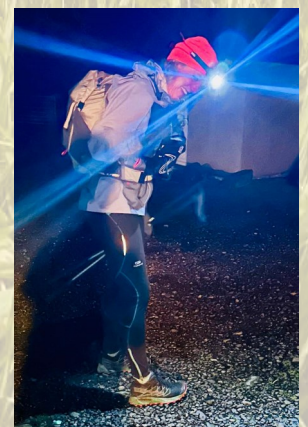
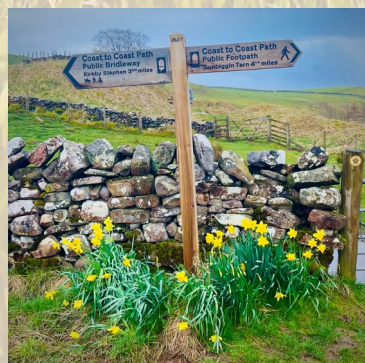
Katie successfully completed her 'Run4Nature' 'I DID IT!'
